
Dormant Accounts ... Keep your funds in your hands

Inactive accounts must be reported to the State each year. The State of Arizona requires all financial institutions to forward any funds in accounts that have had no activity for three years, as of the previous June 30th.

To protect your funds ...

- Make a transaction at least once a year—deposit or withdrawal.
- Notify the credit union when your phone number or address changes—Be sure to keep your contact information current.
- Close accounts that you no longer use.
