
With Shared Accounts, you can grant select family and friends who have an account at Alhambra, access to your accounts or link your multiple accounts at Alhambra for easy access.


1. After logging into your home page, select the **Share My Accounts** option from the **Accounts** content box.



Once this option is selected, you will be redirected to *User Preferences / Share My Account* section. You can view and/or edit your current Shared Accounts you have setup or you can select the *Add New Share* option to create a new shared account.



3. You will be presented with the following options:



Member: Enter the Member Number of the member that you want to share your account with.


Last Name: Enter the Last Name of the member that you want to share your account with.

Account: Select which Share/Loan account you want to share with another member.

Name: This is how the account name will appear on the other member's home page.

Expires: Select the date you want this Shared Account to expire or, it can be set to never expire. **Permissions:** You will have various permissions you can choose from that will limit the account access.

4. Once you create the new Shared Account, the member you shared the account with will see that account on their home screen within the Accounts content box under the Shared Accounts section. Based on the permissions that were granted, the recipient member can now view the balance, review history transactions, transfer to/from or rename the account.



5. Should you want to discontinue this service please delete the Shared Account under User Preferences.
